The Central Regional Education Association has set forth an initiative to develop and implement a New Teacher Support Program for first-year teachers employed by the school districts that are members of CREA. We believe the benefits of this program will provide first-year teachers with a professional growth opportunity, ongoing support/guidance, and professional dialogue with colleagues.

## What is involved in participating in the New Teacher Program?

The CREANew Teacher Support Network will consist of a self-paced course, along with virtual coaching and monthly meetings to provide opportunities for communication and collaboration. These monthly meetings will be held via Zoom to make joining convenient for all participants. Participants will have the opportunity to go through a self-paced course with quality training and will join our monthly meetings to collaborate on timely topics lead by regional education leaders. There is no cost to participants to attend the CREANew Teacher Support Network.
